

Biker saves cop knocked down by car

The police are looking for a car driver who knocked down a constable who was riding on his motorbike on the Mulund Link Road in the early hours of Sunday.

Constable Manohar Jangapalle, 30, who is admitted to Fortis Hospital, Mulund, had fractured his hands and suffered head injuries. The police said the incident happened at around 1:30 am when Jangapalle was going back to his Airoli home after finishing his duty.

They said Jangapalle was lying unconscious in a pool of blood till a passing biker took him to the hospital and informed the police.

Regular commuters on the road said there are no streetlights on the service lane adjacent to highway, making it an accident-prone area.

He (victim) gave details of the accident and said a car hit him. He fell unconscious and is not aware of what happened later

The police said there are no CCTV cameras in the vicinity and Jangapalle had still not recovered enough to record his statement. "He gave details of the accident while he reached the hospital and said a car hit him from behind and did not stop. He soon fell unconscious and is not aware of what happened later," said an officer from Navghar police station.
