LUDHIANA: Fortis Hospital conducted an emergency response drill for its departments on Tuesday.

The exercise, called the Code Yellow mock drill, was aimed at testing the hospital's emergency response team in a crisis situation and spotting weak areas.

The exercise began at 2.30 pm, when the hospital brought in externally simulated 'patients', with wrist bands of various colours to categorize various patients: red for emergent, yellow indicating urgent, green for not urgent and black for dead. Immediate advanced life support systems were administered according to categories.

Two contact numbers were generated for queries. Continuous flow of information was generated on the status of the patients. The drill ended at 3.30 pm.
