Rotarians to help treat seven children from Rwanda

CHANDIGARH: The Rotary Club received seven children from Rwanda on Sunday, who will undergo heart surgeries under the Rotary Helpline project. The youngest among them is Evan, a 7-month-old baby suffering from Downs syndrome. The children who will be treated include Prince (9), Brigitte (9), Josiane (14), Dativa (14), Fils (17), Vedastine (15), and Evan (7 months). They were accompanied by Dr Emmanuel Rusingiza Kamanzi, Heshima Christophe and Evan's mother Uhiriwe Chantal. Most of these children suffer from rheumatic heart disease, while some have leaking heart valves. They will be operated on by Dr T S Mahant, executive director CTVS at Fortis Hospital in Mohali.
